OneWorld Classrooms' K-12 International Art Exchange is:

- an easy way for your classes to share student-created artwork with their peers from around the world and develop related curriculum-based lessons
- an authentic source for learning about global cultures
- aligned with art, language arts, foreign language and social studies curricula

How to participate: You mail your students' artwork to us (US address); we mail you student artwork from up to 12 locations around the world, matching your grade level.

You also get: Specific participation guidelines; lesson and curriculum connection ideas; Email or phone support; PowerPoints and VoiceThreads featuring student art; and Google Earth tours to all participating schools, with digitized artwork, student photos and teacher letters. Starting at \$200/ exchange, with options to add a Premier International Student Art Display at your school, trace your students' art around the world, interact with an overseas partner (Skype or Email) and tailor an exchange to match the cultural roots of your students (includes our Global Roots Curriculum).
